Coaching Experience:

Coach Kal Radwan, aka Coach Rod, has coached soccer for over 20 years. He spent years in Egypt as a coach, trainer and advisor for many first division teams. In addition, he has appeared as a guest speaker for college teams, as well as a program writer and director for various other club organizations in Egypt.

Coach Rod coached for Middlesex College for the 2012-2013 season, bringing the team to the playoffs for the first time in 9 years and becoming a tournament finalist.

He also served as a head and assistant coach, as well as a technical trainer for Quickstrike FC for 6 years until 2014, coaching boys and girls ages 9 – 18 years old.

From 2007 to 2011, Coach Rod served as head and assistant coach for Carmel High School boys junior varsity and varsity teams, making several sectional appearances. He was successful in developing these boys' abilities and passion for the game, helping to cultivate their college soccer careers.

From 2001 to 2003, Coach Rod trained the u21 division 1 men's Al-Nasr club in Dubai, UAE, serving as a soccer trainer as well as their conditioning trainer. They became a Dubai Cup finalist and the champions in Dubai Summer Super Cup, as well as a two-year league champion.

Coach Rod now spends his time as head coach of the boys Poughkeepsie Heat, focusing on technical development to prepare them for the premiership level.
